

DJ MEDICAL HAND TRACTION DEVICE

The DJ Medical Traction Device, an accessory attachment to the DJ Medical Hand Table, is a unique patented device (U.S. Pat 5,735,806) to apply traction to the hand and wrist during surgery. It is self contained and completely sterilizable. The surgeon attaches it to the table top after prepping and draping. The traction device, which is at table top level, is sterile for the duration of the procedure. It has a simple cam lock mechanism on a rope to supply traction for the duration of the surgical procedure. A release mechanism operated by the surgeon releases traction at any time.

As the entire traction apparatus remains sterile throughout the procedure, all adjustments are made by the surgeon or

assistant. It is not necessary to have an O.R. tech or circulating nurse attach weights. Release of the traction during the procedure is done by the surgeon, and it is simple to reapply the traction again during the procedure.
